FREE Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is Available

PPE such as masks, gloves and eye protection is available to child care facilities in Philadelphia. In addition, other supplies necessary to meet CDC health and safety [guidelines](#) for child care centers will be included such as disinfectant, sanitizer, soap, and no touch thermometers.

How do I know if my program is eligible?

Providers actively participating in PHMC Health & Safety TA will be prioritized to match the supplies with increased knowledge of best practices. All DHS licensed Philadelphia child care providers are eligible to apply.

Priority will also go to programs that participated in select initiatives including Philadelphia Emergency Fund for Stabilization of Early Education (PEFSEE), PHMC ECE Business Stabilization TA, PHMC ECE COVID-19 Health & Safety TA, PCCY SBA Loan Application TA, First Up Business TA, or Business Best Practices Series presented by Children’s Village.

If you did not participate in any of these programs, and would like to be considered to receive PPE, submit your request for Health & Safety TA NOW!

How do I apply?

Prioritized providers received a direct link from PHMC to request PPE. If you meet the eligibility requirements and have not received a link to request your supplies, please contact ECEProviderSupport@phmc.org.
